

ORDER OF  
REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE

TO PRACTICE AS A  
REGISTERED PROFESSIONAL NURSE  
IN THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Nursing ("Board") upon receipt of respondent's petition for reinstatement of his nursing license. Mr. Dupont's license had been suspended by means of a Final Order of Discipline entered on April 17, 2015 because of his failure to fully respond to a Board inquiry concerning an arrest. In addition, the Final Order

of Discipline found that Mr. Dupont failed to timely complete required continuing education for the 2010-2012 licensing cycle, and that he engaged in misrepresentation on his 2012 renewal application by indicating that he would complete all required continuing education for the 2010-2012 licensing cycle by May 31, 2012. A reprimand for misrepresentation and a total of \$750 in civil penalties, including \$500 for the failure to fully respond to the Board's inquiry, and \$250 for the failure to timely complete continuing education in violation of N.J.A.C. 13:37-5.3, were imposed by the April 17, 2015 order.

Respondent has now provided all the information and documentation originally requested by the Board, demonstrating that the assault-related charges against him had been dismissed and the record has been expunged. Respondent has also paid the \$750 in civil penalties imposed by the Final Order of Discipline.

The Board finding that reinstatement of respondent's license to practice nursing is appropriate at this time, in accordance with the conditions for reinstatement set by the April 17, 2015 Final Order of Discipline, and for other good cause shown;

IT IS, ON THIS *4<sup>th</sup>* DAY OF *August*, 2015  
HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent's petition for reinstatement of his license to practice nursing in the State of New Jersey is granted upon review and approval of a completed application for reinstatement, if not already submitted, along with any requisite fees, information, and required continuing education, and the Criminal History Background Check, if applicable.
