This matter was first opened to the State Board of Pharmacy upon receipt of information that Lina Ludwikowski, R.Ph. (a.k.a. Lina Zangari) ("Respondent"), had applied for an unrestricted license to practice pharmacy. On September 21, 2012, Respondent entered into a Consent Order in which her license to practice pharmacy was suspended following Respondent's arrest on January 18, 2012 by the Mount Laurel Township Police Department, having been charged with obtaining controlled dangerous substances by fraud. Respondent admitted to her pharmacy employer that on various occasions she had called-in fraudulent and unauthorized prescriptions for insulin which she then dispensed for the use of her boyfriend's dog and, on one occasion, had reduced the price of the medication because she could not afford the cost.

On other occasions, Respondent called in fraudulent and unauthorized prescriptions which she then dispensed for Prozac, Zithromax, and Macrobid for her own use, Cialis for her boyfriend, and Valtrex and Tylenol #3 (a schedule III controlled substance) for her boyfriend's son. The Consent Order imposed a two (2) year suspension, with the first three (3) months served as a period of active suspension and the remaining period stayed and served as a period of probation. Respondent was also required to successfully complete a board-approved ethics course.

Respondent has been practicing on probation since December 2012. She has now presented the Board with documentation that she has received an "unconditional Pass" in the ProBe course and is in full compliance with the provisions of the September 21, 2012 Consent Order.

Respondent, being desirous of resolving this matter without the necessity of further formal proceedings, and agreeing to waive any right to same, and the Board having determined that this Order is sufficiently protective of the public health, safety and welfare, and all parties agreeing to the terms of this Order;

1. Lina Ludwikowski (a.k.a. Lina Zangari), R.Ph., is hereby granted an unrestricted license to practice pharmacy in the State of New Jersey.
