This matter was opened to the Professional Counselor Examiners Committee of the New Jersey State Board of Marriage and Family Therapy Examiners ("Committee") upon receipt of information indicating that Radha Singh, Licensed Associate Counselor ("Respondent") was arrested on July 17, 2015 by the Passaic County Prosecutor's Office for violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:14-2c(3)(b), Sexual Assault, Actor Has Supervisory or Disciplinary Power Over

Victim and N.J.S.A. 2C:24-4a, Engage in Sexual Conduct Impair/Debauch Morals of a Child. Specifically, it is alleged that Respondent engaged in sexual conduct with her 17-year old patient on multiple occasions. The victim gave a statement to the police detailing the sexual relationship with Respondent and, it is alleged that, in a video recorded interview, Respondent admitted to engaging in sexual conduct with the victim on multiple occasions.

The alleged conduct, if proven, constitutes a violation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(f) in that Respondent has engaged in conduct constituting crimes involving moral turpitude or relating adversely to the activity regulated by the Committee and engaged in gross malpractice in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(c), establishing a basis for disciplinary action against Respondent.

It appearing that Respondent wishes to voluntarily enter into an interim agreement without making admissions and without prejudice to Respondent's ability to defend the allegations against her; the Committee finding that the public health, safety and welfare is adequately protected, and other good cause having been shown;

IT IS on this 3 day of September, 2015;

ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent is hereby granted leave and shall immediately surrender her license, to be deemed a suspension, to practice as an associate counselor in the State of New Jersey pending disposition

of the criminal charges, and until further Order of the Committee. Respondent shall, contemporaneously with the signing of this Order, mail her license to practice associate counseling to Executive Director Milagros Collazo, Professional Counselors Examiners Committee, State Board of Marriage and Family Therapists, P.O. Box 45010, Newark, New Jersey, 07101.

2. Respondent shall immediately cease and desist from holding herself out as a licensed associate counselor and/or practicing as a licensed associate counselor or providing any counseling or mental health services in any capacity and in any setting in this State. Any practice in this State prior to reinstatement shall constitute grounds for a charge of unlicensed practice.

3. Nothing herein shall preclude the Committee from initiating disciplinary action based upon the conduct relating to Respondent as alleged above. The entry of the within Order is without prejudice to the further investigation and/or prosecution of any violations by Respondent of any statutes or regulations governing the practice of counseling in the State or any violations of law, by the Committee, the Attorney General, or any other regulatory or law enforcement agency, including but not limited to any pending matters under investigation.

4. Nothing contained herein shall be deemed an admission of liability on the part of the Respondent.

5. Any violation of this order by Respondent shall constitute grounds for disciplinary action.
