



prescription drugs, one count of conspiracy to commit mail fraud and wire fraud, one count of conspiracy to commit money laundering (domestic promotion), and one count of conspiracy to commit money laundering (international promotion).

On or about May 15th, 2015, following a two week trial, Respondent was found guilty in the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York of the following charges: one count of conspiracy to introduce misbranding prescription drugs into interstate commerce; misbranding prescription drugs while held for sale, with intent to defraud or mislead; one count of introducing misbranded prescription drugs into interstate commerce with intent to defraud or mislead; one count of conspiracy to commit mail fraud and wire fraud; one count of mail fraud; and one count of wire fraud.

On September 2, 2015, Respondent was sentenced to three (3) years in prison followed by two (2) years of supervised release. Respondent was also fined \$500.00 and ordered to forfeit \$2,500,000. Respondent intends to appeal her conviction.

The parties being desirous of resolving this matter, and the Board, being satisfied that entry of the within Order obviates the need for formal proceedings, and being further satisfied that good cause exists to support entry of the within Order,

IT IS THEREFORE, ON THIS 30<sup>th</sup> DAY OF September 2015,

**ORDERED AND AGREED THAT**

1. Respondent, Lena Congtang a/k/a Lena Lasher, R.Ph.'s license to practice pharmacy in the State of New Jersey is hereby voluntarily surrendered with such surrender to be deemed a revocation.

2. Respondent shall immediately return her original New Jersey pharmacy license to the New Jersey State Board of Pharmacy, P.O. Box 45013, Newark, NJ 07101.

3. The parties hereby stipulate that entry of this Order is without prejudice to further action, investigation or restrictions upon reinstatement, by this Board, the Attorney General, the Drug Control Unit, the Director of the Division of Consumer Affairs or other law enforcement entities resulting from Respondents' conduct prior to entry of this Order.

4. The parties also stipulate that Respondent shall be permitted to make application for reinstatement of her license upon reversal in whole or part of her conviction, which the Board may grant subject to such limitations as it may determine to be appropriate.
