The Professional Counselor Examiners Committee (hereinafter the "Committee") of the New Jersey Board of Marriage and Family Therapy Examiners, has reviewed the application of Bianca Kazoun ("Respondent") to lift the restrictions on her license to practice as a professional counselor in New Jersey. By Consent Order filed on June 23, 2014 ("the Consent Order"), Respondent was required to practice under the supervision of a Committee

approved supervisor for a period of one (1) year and was prohibited from acting as a supervisor. The Consent Order was based upon the Committee's findings that Respondent engaged in professional misconduct by authoring a letter containing a clinical evaluation of a client's mother who was not Respondent's client.

Having reviewed the entire record, the Committee has determined that Respondent has satisfied the terms of the Consent Order and that Respondent is fit and competent to practice professional counseling in New Jersey without restriction. The parties desiring to resolve this matter without further proceedings, and the Committee finding this Consent Order to be adequately protective of the public interest, and other good cause appearing;

HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The restrictions contained in the Consent Order of June 23, 2014 are hereby terminated and Respondent may practice professional counseling in the State of New Jersey without restriction.
