This matter was opened to the New Jersey Board of Pharmacy upon the petition of Pharmacy Creations, LLC for an unrestricted permit to operate a pharmacy in the State of New Jersey. On May 14, 2014, Pharmacy Creations, LLC entered an Interim Consent Order with the New Jersey Board of Pharmacy which required the evaluation and ongoing monitoring of sterile compounding and related activities at Pharmacy Creations, LLC. On July 21, 2014, following a preliminary positive result for mold growth in 50 ml vials of Ascorbic Acid injectable 500mg/ml, Pharmacy Creations, LLC entered a second Interim Order which further required Pharmacy Creations LLC to (1) quarantine all sterile preparations until receipt of 14-day sterility results - negative for contamination - from contracted laboratories; (2) report all preliminary and confirmed incidents of product contamination to the Board within 48 hours of becoming aware of

such incidents; and (3) in the event of any future preliminary or confirmed incidents of product contamination, Pharmacy Creations, LLC shall immediately obtain two independently performed 14-day sterility reports per lot number.

Pharmacy Creations has been fully compliant with all terms of both the May and July 2014 Consent Orders and it appears that there have been no additional occurrences of contamination.

The Board finding the within disposition adequately protective of the public health, safety and welfare, and other good cause having been shown;

IT IS, therefore, on this 7th day of December 2015

ORDERED THAT:

1. The permit issued to Pharmacy Creations, LLC to operate a pharmacy in the State of New Jersey shall immediately be considered unrestricted and no longer subject to the requirements outlined in the May and July 2014 Consent Orders.
