

These facts establish a basis for disciplinary action pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(n). It appearing that the respondent desires to resolve this matter without recourse to formal proceedings, and the Board finding the entry of the Consent Order to be in the public interest,

HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED THAT


1. Respondent shall cease and desist permitting unlicensed persons to provide social work services, and shall ensure that all individuals whom she supervises are properly licensed as required by law.

2. Respondent is hereby assessed a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,000.00 for aiding and abetting the unlicensed clinical practice of Lori Yakita. The penalty shall be paid by certified check or money order made payable to the State of New Jersey and submitted to J. Michael Walker, Executive Director, State Board of Social Work Examiners, PO Box 45033, New Jersey 07101, within fourteen days of the entry of the within Consent Order.
