FINAL DECISION AFTER UPL

PRACTICING SPEECH LANGUAGE  
PATHOLOGY

This matter was opened before the New Jersey State Audiology And Speech Language Pathology Advisory Committee ("the Advisory Committee ("the Committee") upon the issuance of a Uniform Penalty Letter ("UPL") to Alexandra Moradi (hereinafter referred to as "the Respondent"), for the violation of the following: N.J.A.C. 13:44C-6.2 and 6.6 in that evidence of 20 documented hours of Continuing Professional Education (CPE) shall be required biennially of each applicant for renewal and that the CPE hours must be accredited by the New Jersey Commission on Higher Education, or accredited or sponsored by a local, state or national audiology and speech-language pathology professional organization, local, state, or Federal education or health agency, or a local, state or national medical, psychological, dental or similar professional organization. Courses accepted for credit by the National Registry on Continuing Education or by the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association will be

given credit by the Committee.

A UPL was served upon Respondent on April 2, 2015 by regular mail and certified mail with return receipt requested to Respondent's address of record at 931 Salem Avenue, Hillside, New Jersey 07205. Respondent was accorded 20 business days to acknowledge the charge: (1) settle the matter and desist from further violations and pay a penalty; (2) waive a hearing and submit a written explanation of the charge, or (3) request a formal administrative hearing.

Correspondence was received from Respondent on April 23, 2015 which expressed Respondent's desire to pay the civil penalty and submit proof of satisfactory completion of 20 continuing education hours within 4 months. Respondent provided to the Committee proof of satisfactory completion of 20 continuing education hours for the November 1, 2013 to October 31, 2015 renewal period and full payment of the civil penalty assessed. A review of the submitted CPE proof demonstrated that you completed 20 CPE hours after the October 31, 2013 deadline. Upon review the Committee has accepted the 20 CE hours although untimely received.

Accordingly, IT IS on this 9 day of December, 2015

ORDERED as follows:

1. The Committee accepts the 20 hours submitted after the applicable renewal date to qualify for completion of your outstanding 2013- 2015 CE credits.
2. The 20 continuing professional education credits submitted to satisfy this order cannot be used towards the next biennial renewal.
3. Respondent's license to practice speech language pathology remains active.
4. The civil penalty imposed in this matter was paid in full by the Respondent.
