

This matter was opened to the State Board of Pharmacy upon receipt of information that Nicole Ardite, R.Ph., had applied for an unrestricted license to practice pharmacy. By Consent Order filed on July 21, 2011, Ms. Ardite surrendered her license to practice pharmacy based upon allegations that she had diverted controlled substances for her own consumption while employed at Target Pharmacy. She complied fully with all Board requirements and, by Consent Order dated January 4, 2013, her license was reinstated and placed on probation for a period of 2

years. During the probationary period, Ms. Ardite was required to remain enrolled in and comply fully with the Professional Assistance Program and was precluded from acting as preceptor, pharmacist-in-charge or having an ownership interest in any pharmacy.

Ms. Ardite is now seeking to remove all restrictions from her license to practice pharmacy and has presented the Board with documentation showing compliance with the requirements of all prior Orders. The Professional Assistance Program supports her petition for an unrestricted license.

The Board having determined that the within Order is adequately protective of the public health, safety, and welfare;
