This matter was opened to the Board of Massage and Bodywork Therapy ("the Board") upon receipt of the application of Dongsuk David for licensure as a massage and bodywork therapist. Upon a review of the application and the criminal history background check, it was ascertained by the Board that the applicant had been arrested on or about September 7, 2006 on charges relating

to prostitution. Ms. David was found not guilty of any prostitution-related charges, but was convicted of a local ordinance violation, and assessed \$2,025 in fines and costs. Ms. David disclosed the arrest on her application.

The Board notes that the 2006 arrest took place on the premises of a spa providing massage services, but notes that the arrest is distant in time, and appears to be an isolated incident, as no subsequent arrests have occurred. Ms. David maintains that she was acting as a receptionist at the time.

The Board finding that granting the applicant's request for licensure is appropriate under the circumstances, but that certain conditions should nonetheless imposed on licensure and for other good cause shown;

IT IS ON THIS 19th DAY OF *January*, 2016

HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:

1. The application for licensure shall be granted upon Ms. McLaughlin's demonstration that she has satisfied other licensure requirements, if she has not already done so. Ms. David shall be placed on probation for a period of tthree years, dating from the filing of this Order. The conditions of probation are set forth below.

2. Ms. David shall report to the Board within five (5) business days any arrest, indictment or conviction for any crime or disorderly persons offense.

3. Ms. David shall obey all the laws of the State of New Jersey, the United States and their political subdivisions as well as all regulations, rules or laws pertaining to the practice of massage and bodywork therapy in the State or jurisdiction in which she practices massage and bodywork therapy.

4. Any deviation from the terms of this Order without the prior written consent of the Board shall constitute a failure to comply with the terms of this Order. Upon receipt of any reliable information indicating that the applicant has violated any term of this Order, the Ms. David's license may be automatically suspended by the Board. Ms. David, upon notice, may request a hearing to contest the entry of such an order. At any such hearing, the sole issue shall be whether any of the information received regarding Ms. David was materially false.

6. At the end of the term of probation, Ms. David may petition the Board in writing for release from the terms of this Order. In the event that there have been no arrests or convictions during the period of probation, the Board may then grant such a petition by means of a written communication, without need for further Order of the Board.
