**ORDER REINSTATING  
LICENSE**

This matter is before the Board on the application of Anna Padva-German, D.D.S. ("Dr. Padva-German" or "respondent") for reinstatement of her license to practice dentistry. Respondent entered into a consent order with the Board in November 2010, following her guilty plea to charges of Medicaid fraud. The terms of the consent order included a one year suspension, of which six months was an active suspension. The consent order included a provision that she would not be given credit toward the active suspension if she were engaged in the practice of dentistry in any other jurisdiction. Respondent holds a


were engaged in the practice of dentistry in any other jurisdiction. Respondent holds a license in New York State. The New York licensing authority took action based on the New Jersey State Board action, imposing a two year suspension, six months active. Dr. Padva-German completed the active portion of that suspension between January and July 2015, and, having refrained from practice for a period of six months, has met the active period of her suspension under the terms of the Board's consent order.

On November 18, 2015, Dr. Padva-German appeared before the Board with her counsel, R. Bruce Crelin. Respondent discussed the circumstances surrounding her conviction and insights she has gained from the experience. Based on her testimony, the Board finds that Dr. Padva-German has demonstrated an understanding of her conduct and that such conduct is unlikely to be repeated. Reinstating her New Jersey license is consistent with the public health, safety, and welfare.

THEREFORE, IT IS ON THIS 26<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF JANUARY, 2016,

ORDERED that the license of Anna Padva-German, D.D.S., to practice dentistry is reinstated without restriction.
