

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Pharmacy (the "Board") upon receipt of information alleging that respondent Katherine Campanale ("respondent") had forged multiple prescriptions for herself and her family while working as a pharmacy technician at Costco. Costco provided information suggesting respondent forged multiple prescriptions for a variety of drugs. Respondent provided a handwritten statement admitting that she forged prescriptions for insulin for her son. She agreed to accept whatever discipline the Board deemed appropriate.

After a review of the materials presented, the Board finds that the appropriate resolution is to permit respondent to voluntarily and permanently surrender her registration to practice as a pharmacy technician in New Jersey in accordance with the terms of this Order. The Board

having reviewed the information presented, finds the within disposition adequately protective of the public health, safety and welfare, and respondent having waived her right to a hearing in this matter, and other good cause having been shown,

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS on this 9 day of January, 2016

ORDERED AND AGREED that:

1. Respondent is hereby granted leave and shall immediately and permanently surrender her registration to practice as a pharmacy technician in the State of New Jersey, to be deemed a revocation of her registration. Respondent agrees that she will not reapply for registration as a pharmacy technician in the State of New Jersey.

2. Respondent shall immediately cease and desist from engaging in practice as a pharmacy technician, which includes, but is not limited to the following: respondent shall not retrieve prescription files or patient files; shall not prepare medication labels; shall not engage in data entry for any pharmacy, shall not count, weigh, measure, pour or compound prescription medication or stock legend drugs and controlled substances; shall not fill an automated medication system; shall not accept authorization for a prescription refill or renewal; shall not handle anything requiring a prescription, including devices and medications; shall not handle prescriptions; and shall not be present within a prescription filling area of a pharmacy.

3. Respondent shall surrender her wall certificate, wallet certificate, and the most recent renewal card of her registration to the Executive Director of the Board by mailing them to Anthony Rubinaccio, Executive Director, Board of Pharmacy, P. O. Box 45013, Newark, New Jersey 07101.

4. Any practice in this State in violation of the above conditions shall constitute unlicensed practice and/or grounds for discipline for violation of a Board Order and professional misconduct.
