This matter was opened to the State Board of Pharmacy upon receipt of information that Mark Cardis, R.Ph., had applied for an unrestricted license to practice pharmacy. By Consent Order filed on July 14, 2011, Mr. Cardis agreed to remain enrolled in and comply fully with the Professional Assistance Program, abstain from the use of all psychoactive substances, and refrain from acting as preceptor, pharmacist-in-charge or having an ownership interest in any pharmacy. This Consent Order was entered following allegations that Mr. Cardis created fictitious pharmacy records for prescriptions for controlled substances filled by him for his own use; and that these prescriptions were, in some instances, not authorized by a physician.

Mr. Cardis is now seeking to remove all restrictions from his license to practice pharmacy and has presented the Board with documentation showing compliance with the requirements of the July 2011 Consent Order. The Professional Assistance Program unconditionally supports his petition for an unrestricted license and notes that he has been in ongoing documented recovery for approximately 7 years.

The Board having determined that the within Order is adequately protective of the public health, safety, and welfare;

ORDERED:

1. The license issued to Mark Cardis to practice pharmacy in the State of New Jersey shall immediately be considered unrestricted and no longer subject to the requirements outlined in the July 2011 Consent Orders, effective September 2, 2015, the day the Board voted to grant said unrestricted license.
