This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Nursing (the "Board") upon receipt of a written petition from April Skill, RN ("Respondent") to reinstate her license to practice as a Registered Professional Nurse. By Final Order of Discipline filed on January 6, 2012, Respondent's license to practice nursing was suspended for failure to comply with a Board order in violation of N.J.A.C. 13:45C-1.4, subjecting Respondent to sanctions pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(e), in that Respondent failed to make timely monthly payments of \$200.00 for a \$3,108.95 penalty imposed pursuant to a May 10, 2005 Final

Consent Order. A Board investigation in 2004-2005 had found that Respondent engaged in professional misconduct while employed at a home care agency when she prepared assessments and other forms based upon information obtained via telephone in lieu of face-to-face visits. The May 2005 Order imposed a two-year stayed suspension and costs of \$3,108.95.

By Final Order of discipline filed on January 06, 2012, Respondent's license to practice nursing as a Registered Professional Nurse was suspended for failure to make timely monthly payments for a penalty initially assessed by Order on May 10, 2005.

On November 5, 2015, with her petition for reinstatement, Respondent provided complete restitution of her outstanding penalty in the amount of \$1,308.95.

The Board has determined that Respondent, in satisfying the outstanding balance of \$1,308.95, has complied with the terms of the January 6, 2012 Final Order and that her license should be reinstated. The Board has, therefore, determined that the within Order is sufficiently protective of the public health, safety and welfare; and in lieu of further proceedings, and for other good cause shown;


IT IS on this 3rd day of February, 2016
