

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Nursing ("Board") upon receipt of information that respondent failed to comply with N.J.S.A. 45:11-24(d)(27) and N.J.A.C. 13:37-5.3 in that the respondent failed to timely complete continuing education requirements for the June 1, 2012 through May 31, 2014 renewal period. Respondent advised the Board of this lack of compliance with regulatory requirements when the respondent's nursing license was renewed in 2014.

Respondent has since provided the Board with documentation of having belatedly satisfied the above-referenced continuing

education requirements, and has paid a \$250.00 civil penalty assessed pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(h) for the violation of a regulation administered by the Board.


The Board finding that inasmuch as respondent has been provided with notice of the imposition of the civil penalty, and notice by letter that the within Order reflecting payment would be filed subsequent to respondent's payment of the penalty, and finding that the entry of the within Order in order to memorialize the Board's finding of a regulatory violation, and for other good cause shown;

HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:

1. A civil penalty in the amount of \$250.00 is hereby imposed for the violation of N.J.A.C. 13:37-5.3, which penalty has already been paid in full.
