THIS MATTER was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Architects ("Board") upon receipt of information that on or about October 21, 2014, the New York Board of Regents adopted the provisions set forth in an "Application for Consent Order" ("New

York Consent Order") executed by the Respondent, Amiel Savaldi, RA, at which time his New York license to practice architecture was suspended for one (1) year, which was stayed, and he was placed on probation for one (1) year with certain terms and conditions.

More specifically, Respondent agreed not to contest the Fourth Specification of professional misconduct, as set forth more fully in a "Statement of Charges", charging him with committing unprofessional conduct for receiving fees from a third party in connection with the performance of professional services.

As a result of the foregoing, the Board has determined that the New York disciplinary action provides a basis to take disciplinary action against Respondent's New Jersey license to practice architecture pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(g).

IT NOW APPEARING that the parties wish to resolve this matter without recourse to formal proceedings; and that the Respondent hereby waives any right to a hearing in this matter; and the Board finding the within Order adequately protects the public's health, safety and welfare; and for good cause shown;

IT IS ON THIS 19th day of February, 2016, **ORDERED AND AGREED** that Respondent's license to practice architecture in the State of New Jersey shall be, and hereby is, suspended for a period of one (1) year, to be stayed in its entirety, effective upon the date of this Consent Order. Respondent further agrees to remain

in full compliance with the provisions set forth in the New York
Consent Order.
