The Professional Counselor Examiners Committee (hereinafter the "Committee") of the New Jersey Board of Marriage and Family Therapy Examiners, has reviewed the application of Heather Devenuto ("Respondent") to terminate the restrictions on her license imposed by a September 24, 2014 Consent Order (the

"Consent Order"). The terms of the Consent Order require Respondent to practice under the supervision of a Committee approved supervisor for a minimum period of one (1) year and prohibit Respondent from acting as a supervisor. The Consent Order reinstated Respondent's license with supervision restrictions following a January 23, 2013 Consent Order which placed Respondent's license into inactive status as a result of her arrest and failure to cooperate with a Board investigation into the arrest.

Having reviewed the entire record, the Committee has determined that Respondent has satisfied the terms of the Consent Order and that Respondent is fit and competent to practice professional counseling in New Jersey without restriction. The parties desiring to resolve this matter without further proceedings, and the Committee finding this Consent Order to be adequately protective of the public interest, and other good cause appearing;

IT IS ON THIS 3 DAY OF March, 2016,

HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The restrictions contained in the Consent Order of September 4, 2014 are hereby terminated and Respondent may practice professional counseling in the State of New Jersey

without restriction.
