This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Nursing (the "Board") upon receipt of a written petition from Lyndsay Paul, RN ("Respondent") to reinstate her license to practice as a Registered Professional Nurse. By Order of Suspension filed on March 9, 2015, Respondent's license to practice nursing was suspended for failure to comply with the terms of her January 2, 2104, private letter agreement and was found to be in violation of N.J.A.C. 13:45C-1.4, subjecting Respondent to sanctions pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(e), and an automatic suspension of her license.

On September 23, 2015, with her petition for reinstatement, Respondent provided proof of consistent and

continued monitoring by the Professional Assistance Program of New Jersey.

The Board has determined that Respondent has provided satisfactory documentation to prove that she has complied with the terms of the March 9, 2015 Order of Suspension, and that her license should be reinstated. The Board has, therefore, determined that the within Order is sufficiently protective of the public health, safety and welfare; and in lieu of further proceedings, and for other good cause shown;


IT IS on this 8<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2016
