

**FINAL CONSENT ORDER OF
VOLUNTARY SURRENDER OF
REGISTRATION**

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Pharmacy ("Board) upon receipt of information alleging that A1 Pharmacy located at 1009 Broadway, Bayonne, New Jersey 07002 was engaged in the improper dispensing or distribution of prescription medications including Tramadol and Fioricet. Diedre Chatmon is the majority owner and permit holder of A1 Pharmacy ("Respondent") located at 1009 Broadway, Bayonne, New Jersey 07002 which holds NJ CDS registration D10413300.

Specifically, Respondent has been alleged to have operated A1 Pharmacy without the proper credentials. Further A1 Pharmacy is alleged to have dispensed Prescription Legend Drugs and shipped them to patients in various parts of the United States without obtaining documented proof of a legitimate physician/patient relationship between the prescribing physician and the patient.

Respondent, being desirous of resolving this matter without the necessity of further formal proceedings, and agreeing to waive any right to same, and the Board, finding the within disposition to be adequately protective of the public health, safety and welfare, and being satisfied that good cause exists for entry of the within Order,

IT IS THEREFORE, ON THIS 30th DAY OF March 2016,

ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:

1. Respondent shall surrender its permit to operate a pharmacy to be deemed a revocation effective immediately. Respondent shall immediately refrain from and stop all pharmacy operations. Pharmacy operations include, but are not limited to: compounding and mailing, dispensing, distributing or delivering in any manner, legend drugs or devices or controlled substances.

2. Respondent shall comply, if applicable, with the regulations pertaining to closing of pharmacies including but not limited to N.J.A.C. 13:39-4.10 and 4.11. Respondent further acknowledges that there is no pharmacy or drug inventory located at

A1 Pharmacy.

3. Hereinafter, Respondent Deidre Chatmon shall not seek a permit to operate a pharmacy and shall not seek a controlled dangerous substance registration in the State of New Jersey.

4. Respondent shall not hold any ownership interest with any pharmacy doing business in New Jersey.

5. Within three months of the filing of this Order Respondent shall sell remaining assets of A1 Pharmacy, if any, subject to Board approval.

6. The entry of the within Order is without prejudice to the further investigation and/or prosecution of any violations by Respondent of any statutes or regulations governing the practice of and operation of a pharmacy in the State or any future violations of law, by the Board, the Attorney General or any other regulatory or law enforcement agency, including but not limited to any pending matters under investigation.

7. Nothing herein shall preclude the Board from initiating further disciplinary action based upon future conduct of Respondent.


