

This matter was first opened to the State Board of Medical Examiners ("the Board") upon receipt of information that Guillermo Munoz, D.O. ("Respondent") had applied for the reinstatement of his medical license.

On October 17, 2015, following Respondent's arrest for a third degree criminal charge of health care claims fraud pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2C:21-4.5, a Consent Order was executed which suspended Respondent's medical license for ten months, with five months to be served as a period of active suspension and the remainder to be

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served as a period of probation. Specifically, it had been alleged that Respondent received payment for the rental of medical office space at more than fair market value in exchange for referrals of patients to Diagnostic Imaging Associates for MRI, CT, and/or other diagnostic testing. It was not alleged that the referrals for diagnostic testing were less than medically necessary. The suspension took effect on November 25, 2015, the date that he entered into the pre-trial intervention program.

On April 27, 2016, Dr. Munoz appeared, with counsel, before the Preliminary Evaluation Committee of the Board in support of his petition for licensure. The Board is satisfied that Dr. Munoz has complied with the terms of the October 17, 2015, Order, including the successful completion a Board-approved ethics course, and is in compliance with the requirements of his pre-trial intervention.

The Board having determined that the within Order is adequately protective of the public health, safety, and welfare,

IT IS ON THIS 13th DAY OF May, 2016

ORDERED that:

1. Pursuant to the terms of the October 17, 2015 Consent Order the remainder of Dr. Munoz's suspension shall be stayed and Respondent shall begin a five (5) month period of probation, which will be terminated five (5) months after the date of filing of this Order. He shall comply with all administrative issues related to the reinstatement of his medical license, including applicable fees

and a criminal background check prior to the reinstatement of his license.

2. Following successful completion of the probationary period, Dr. Munoz shall be granted an unrestricted medical license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey without the need for further appearance before the Board.

3. Dr. Munoz shall cease and desist from any unlawful conduct, including accepting rent at rates higher than fair market value. He shall also comply with all statutes and regulations governing the practice of medicine, including N.J.A.C. 13:35-6.17 (professional fees and investments, prohibition of kickbacks).
