CONSENT ORDER

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Nursing (“Board”) upon receipt of Margarita Camacho’s application for licensure as a Registered Nurse by examination, including voluntary consent to a criminal history background check. Upon review of the results of the criminal history background check, the Board ascertained that the applicant was arrested on July 17, 1998, by members of the Cherry Hill Township Police Department and charged with violating N.J.S.A. 2C:20-11B(1) (Take merchandise from store without intent to pay). On August 11, 1998, the applicant was found guilty in the Cherry Hill Township Municipal Court, of N.J.S.A. 2C:20-11B(1) (Take merchandise from store without intent to pay), and assessed fines and costs totaling four hundred fifty-five dollars (\$455.00).

The applicant failed to disclose her arrest and conviction on her application for licensure, answering “No” to the question on the license application which asked if she had ever been arrested and “No” to the question which asked if she had ever been found guilty of any offense.

The applicant stated that she was under the impression that this incident occurred when she was under 18 years of age and therefore a minor. Her intentions were not to be deceitful, but to show that as an adult she had not been convicted of any crimes.

The applicant acknowledges the arrest and guilty plea. The Board finds that the applicant misrepresented her criminal history on the application which constitutes a violation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(b).

The Board having reviewed this matter, and having considered the nature and timing of the above conduct, and the parties desiring to resolve this matter, and the Board having determined that the within Order is sufficiently protective of the public, in lieu of further proceedings, and for other good cause shown;

IT IS on this 24th day of May, 2016


HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED that:

1. Margarita Camacho's application for licensure as a Registered Nurse by examination shall be granted upon Board review and approval of a completed application and compliance with paragraph two below.


2. A civil penalty in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) is hereby imposed upon the applicant for failing to disclose her arrest and conviction on her application. Payment shall be made by certified check, bank cashier check, or money order payable to "State of New Jersey," or by wire transfer, direct deposit, or credit card payment submitted contemporaneously with this signed Order. Any other form of payment will be rejected and will be returned to the party making the payment.

3. The applicant shall obey all the laws of the State of New Jersey, the United States and their political subdivisions, as well as all regulations, rules or laws pertaining to the practice of nursing in any State or jurisdiction in which she practices nursing.

The New Jersey State Board of Nursing has considered your application for Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) licensure by Endorsement. The Board has decided to grant licensure with the imposition of a civil penalty for failing to disclose arrest and convictions on your application.
