

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This matter was opened to the State Board of Pharmacy upon receipt of information that Kyle J. Colalillo, R.Ph., had applied for an unrestricted license to practice pharmacy. By Consent Order filed on April 11, 2010, Mr. Colalillo surrendered his license to practice pharmacy based upon information he voluntarily provided that he had a possible opiate dependency problem as evidenced by an assessment by the Professional Assistance Program of New Jersey. He complied fully with all Board requirements and, by Consent Order dated November 9, 2011,

his license was reinstated with restrictions. Until further Order of the Board, Mr. Colalillo agreed to remain enrolled in and fully comply with the Professional Assistance Program. Further, Mr. Colalillo was precluded from acting as a pharmacist-in-charge or preceptor, and was barred from being a pharmacy permit holder either directly or indirectly.

Mr. Colalillo is now seeking to remove all restrictions from his license to practice pharmacy and has presented the Board with documentation showing compliance with the requirements of all prior Orders. The Professional Assistance Program supports his petition for an unrestricted license.

The Board having determined that the within Order is adequately protective of the public health, safety, and welfare;

**ORDERED:**

1. Kyle J. Colalillo, R.Ph., is hereby granted an unrestricted license to practice pharmacy in the State of New Jersey, effective retroactive to March 23, 2016, the day the Board voted to grant said unrestricted license.
