**Re: In the Matter of the Unlicensed Practice, Cease And Desist
Complaint No. 90831**

To Whom It May Concern:

The Fire Alarm, Burglar Alarm and Locksmith Advisory Committee has been informed that MS Audio Sound Inc. has been engaged in the installation, service or maintenance of alarm services or electronic security systems while unlicensed to do so. Additionally, a review of Advisory Committee records indicates that MS Audio Sound Inc. is not licensed to engage in the installation, service or maintenance of alarm services or electronic security systems.

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:5A-25, which provides in pertinent part:

(a) No person shall advertise that he is authorized to engage in the alarm business, or otherwise engage in the installation, service or maintenance of burglar alarm, fire alarm or electronic security systems unless he satisfies the requirements of this act.

The Committee has determined that the above violations are sufficient to warrant the initiation of formal disciplinary proceedings against MS Audio Sound Inc., pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-23. The Committee is authorized, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-25, to seek a penalty of \$10,000 for the first violation and not more than \$20,000 for the second and each subsequent violation.

Please be advised, the Advisory Committee has referred the matter to the Board Of Examiners Of Electrical Contractors for its review. Therefore, you may be contacted by the Board if it determines there is cause to do so.

Notwithstanding that determination, however, the Committee is offering MS Audio Sound Inc. an opportunity to settle this matter. In the event that MS Audio Sound Inc. rejects this settlement offer, or fails to respond, the Committee has instructed the Attorney General's Office to initiate formal proceedings.

Therefore, the initiation of formal proceedings will be avoided should MS Audio Sound Inc. consent to the following:

1. MS Audio Sound Inc. shall sign an agreement to immediately cease and desist from advertising that it is authorized to engage in the alarm business, nor shall MS Audio Sound Inc. engage in the installation, service or maintenance of burglar alarm, fire alarm or electronic security systems until duly authorized by the New Jersey Burglar Alarm, Fire Alarm and Locksmith Advisory Committee of the State of New Jersey to do so.

If MS Audio Sound Inc. is willing to settle this matter on the offered settlement terms, an authorized person, with the power to legally bind and obligate MS Audio Sound Inc., should sign this acknowledgment and return it to the Committee office for filing. This letter will then become a matter of public record and will be posted on the Advisory Committee web site.

Since MS Audio Sound Inc. is required to obtain a license, the Advisory Committee encourages you to seek licensure. Please download an application for alarm licensure from the Advisory Committee web site. Also, The Advisory Committee suggests you review its regulations. The regulations are also available for download from the web site.

This Settlement Offer will remain open for thirty (30) days from the date of this letter. In the event that no response is received within thirty (30) days from the date of this letter, it will be assumed that MS Audio Sound Inc. has rejected the Committee's settlement proposal, at which time the settlement offer set forth herein will be withdrawn. The matter will then be considered for the initiation of formal proceedings.

Once again, in the event MS Audio Sound Inc. rejects the offer of settlement, and formal charges are filed, the Advisory Committee can seek civil penalties of \$10,000 for the first violation, and up to \$20,000 for every violation thereafter. Additionally, the Advisory Committee may seek an order requiring MS Audio Sound Inc. to reimburse certain monies and/or requiring MS Audio Sound Inc. to pay additional costs and/or legal fees incurred by the Committee.


