This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Nursing (the "Board") upon receipt of information indicating that in February 2016, Georgia DiClaudio, RN ("Respondent") withdrew from participation with the Board's designated intervention program (the Recovery and Monitoring Program (RAMP)) and wrote to the Board stating that she wished to surrender her nursing license. Respondent mailed the wallet and wall versions of her license to the Board. In her letter, Respondent further stated that she was "perusing different

professional avenues at this time."

Based upon Respondent's withdrawal from RAMP prior to successful completion of the program, the Board finds that testing, monitoring, evaluation, and treatment are warranted as a condition for reinstated licensure to evaluate whether Respondent's continued practice may jeopardize the safety and welfare of the public pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-22(f) and to ensure that Respondent can properly discharge nursing functions pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-22(e).

The Board having reviewed this matter, the parties desiring to resolve this matter without further proceedings, Respondent having waived any right to a hearing, the Board having determined that the within Order is sufficiently protective of the public, and for good cause shown;

HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED that:




1. Respondent hereby voluntarily surrenders her license to practice nursing in the State of New Jersey. Respondent shall not hereafter apply for reinstatement of her license unless and until she can demonstrate that she is fit and competent to practice nursing, has undergone a comprehensive mental health and substance abuse evaluation under the auspices of RAMP, followed the recommendations of the evaluator and RAMP,


gained RAMP's support for reinstatement, and has met all other requirements for reinstatement.
