This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Nursing ("Board") upon receipt of information indicating that on or about May 13, 2015, Ivette Salgado, RN ("Respondent") resigned from her position with Newark Beth Israel Medical Center - Children's Hospital of New Jersey, while under suspension for alleged professional misconduct which relates adversely to patient care or safety. Specifically, it is alleged that Respondent failed to administer the drug Hydralazine, a blood pressure medication, to a pediatric patient; failed to follow a physician-ordered feeding schedule

for another pediatric patient suffering Failure to Thrive; and failed to keep proper records relating to these incidents. Respondent maintains that she has adequate nursing rationale which explains her actions.

The Board finds that Respondent's conduct as outlined above constitutes repeated acts of negligence under N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(d). The parties' desiring to resolve this matter without further proceedings; without any admission of wrongdoing by the Respondent; Respondent waiving any right to a hearing; the Board finding the within resolution adequately protective of the public; and for other good cause shown;

IT IS on this 16<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2016

**HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED that:**


1. Within three (3) months after the date this Order is filed, Respondent shall enroll in and successfully complete a course in documentation and the prevention of medication errors, which shall be approved in advance by the Board. Prior to enrolling in and completing any such course, Respondent shall submit to Deborah Zuccarelli, State Board of Nursing, P.O. Box 45010, Newark, New Jersey, 07101, a written request for approval of the proposed course. No later than one (1) month after completion of the approved course, documentation of successful

completion must be submitted to the Board. No hours or credits earned for completing this course shall be applied towards satisfaction of Respondent's continuing education requirements. This course shall be in addition to the thirty (30) hours of continuing education required for license renewal.

2. Any deviation from the terms of this Order without the prior written consent of the Board shall constitute a failure to comply with the terms of a board order in contravention of N.J.A.C. 13:45C-1.4 and N.J.S.A. 45:1-21 (e) and (h), and shall subject Respondent to the immediate suspension of her license to practice nursing in the state of New Jersey pending further order of the Board.


