Rules of the State Board of Cosmetology and Hairstyling

Authority: N.J.S.A. 45:5B-6.r and s and 45:1-15.1.

New Expiration Date: February 4, 2023.

Take notice that, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-5.1, the rules at N.J.A.C. 13:28 will expire on April 23, 2016. The rules establish standards for the practice and teaching of cosmetology and hairstyling, beauty culture, barbering, manicuring, and skin care specialty. The rules also establish standards for the conduct of shops and schools.

The Board of Cosmetology and Hairstyling has reviewed the rules and has determined them to be necessary, reasonable, and proper for the purpose for which they were originally promulgated, as required by Executive Order No. 66 (1978). Therefore, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:5B-6.r and s and 45:1-15.1, and in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:14B-5.1.c(1), these rules are readopted and shall continue in effect for a seven-year period.
