Notice of Administrative Change

Certification of Interior Designers

Certification without Written Examination (Grandfathering)

Take notice that the Division of Consumer Affairs requested, and the Office of Administrative Law agreed to permit, an administrative change to N.J.A.C. 13:27-9.5(a) to include a date by which an applicant must apply to be certified as an interior designer without written examination. The first official meeting of the certified members of the Interior Design Committee occurred on May 3, 2006. Thus, the time period in which an applicant must apply to be certified as an interior designer without written examination will expire on April 27, 2007. Through this notice, published pursuant to N.J.A.C. 1:30-2.7, the paragraph text is changed to reflect this date.

Full text of the changed rule follows (addition indicated in boldface thus; deletion indicated in brackets [thus]):

**13:27-9.5 Certification without written examination (grandfathering)**

(a) Upon submission of a completed application provided by the Board for certification as a certified interior designer and payment of the application fee set forth in N.J.A.C. 13:27-9.17 and after review and recommendation by the Committee, the Board shall issue, without written examination, a certificate to any person who applies for certification by [(the 360th day after the Committee members first officially meet after having been certified)] April 27, 2007, was a resident of this State on October 22, 2002, and:
