V OLD BUSINESS

A Previously closed disciplinary matter

On May 9, 2013, the Board unanimously voted to issue the settlement letter with the addition of Mr. Pimpao to take two 3-credit college ethics course. On June 12th, the Board reviewed a copy of the signed settlement letter from Mr. Pimpao; a copy of the Board's May 23rd letter regarding the ethics course he needs to complete; and copies of certificates of completion from Mr. Pimpao. The Board tabled this matter until the next meeting. On July 10th, the Board reviewed a copy of the signed settlement letter from Mr. Pimpao; a copy of the Board's May 23rd letter regarding the ethics course he needs to complete; and copies of certificates of completion from Mr. Pimpao. After some discussion, the Board unanimously voted to advise Mr. Pimpao that the courses he took were denied and did not satisfy the requirement in the settlement letter. Advise him that he has 30 days to provide proof that he has signed up for two (2) three-credit college courses on ethics. On September 11, 2014, the Board unanimously voted to send a letter to Mr. Pimpao advising that the professional

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practice course was accepted by the Board. However, the Construction Management course was not approved and he needs to submit an additional course for board approval to comply with the settlement letter.

2/12/15 Mr. Pimpao submits proof and grade for the professional practice course and submits business ethics courses as well as curriculum of three architectural schools for board review and approval.

ACTION: Mr. Zaccone will review the curriculum report to the Board at the April meeting.

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E Legislation

S-2549 which creates Construction Trades Licensing Board for licensing and regulation of several construction professions; creates new division for homeowner protection in Department of Law and Public Safety.

ACTION: Elizabeth Greenblatt, Regulatory Analyst, Division of Consumer Affairs, was present and informed the Board that this Bill was first introduced in 2006 and the Board took no position at that time. The Bill continued to be introduced every year and made no progress. The Division has no new information on this bill or its movement. Mr. Soriano informed the Board that because there was talk at AIA concerning the bill, he asked Mr. Kirk about the bill.

After some discussion, Mr. Zaccone motioned to oppose this bill as the Board agrees with the Division's comments on this bill. Mr. Soriano seconded the motion. It passed unanimously.
