This application appears to comply with statutory requirements.

Summary: This application for a Certificate of Authorization to offer architectural services only is

submitted by a New Jersey architect who owns 34% of the shares in business with two professional engineers who own 66% of the shares. This application appears to comply with statutory requirements.

ACTION: Mr. DeMassi motioned to recommend issuing a Certificate of Authorization to Austin Building and Design - Architect, Inc. Mr. Kniesler seconded the motion. It was unanimously approved.

IX CLOSED CASES

1. ITEM NO. 44751 RUSSILLO, Chuck - Unlicensed Complaint: Hired home improvement contractor for architectural drawings Project: Addition to 1 Oak Lane, Lake Hiawatha NJ

Summary: The complainant alleges that Mr. Russillo took her money to prepare plans for an addition to her house. On February 8th, the Board reviewed the complaint and determined that there appears to be no contract, appears the complainant has a criminal complaint against the respondent, no drawings were filed with the Building department. However, preliminary drawings were done which a contractor is allowed to perform. Review of his business card indicates engineering and architect on staff. The Board would like to know the name of the architect on staff. The Board unanimously determined to find insufficient evidence of a violation of the regulations however, a letter of caution advising that he is not allowed to prepare drawings for construction documents; request he submit the name of the architect as indicated on his business card; and what projects he has worked on with that architect. This matter should be referred to the Board of Professional Engineers for his business card and the word "engineering." On April 12, the Board reviewed a response letter from Mr. Russillo who states that he works with Nancy Socci of Cordasco & Socci and lists three additional projects is attached for review. Also attached is a letter from Nancy Socci who claims to not know the complainant in this matter and she has no contractual relationship with Mr. Russillo. The Board determined to send a letter to Mr. Russillo advising that he must remove the words "architect on staff" from his business card inasmuch as Nancy Socci has informed the Board that she does not work for you. Request that he submit the corrected business card to the Board. On June 14, 2007, Board determined to send a follow up letter advising that Mr. Russillo has 15 days to submit the corrected business card or the Board will reopen this matter and take further action. Mr. Kniesler motioned to recommend accepting the amended business card and close this case. Mr. DeMassi seconded the motion. It was unanimously approved. CASE CLOSED.
