C Correspondence

1 Letter dated June 14, 2006 from Rosemary Varrone, Administrative Manager for Beer & Coleman Architects & Associates who requests clarification of the rule N.J.A.C. 13:27-3.2 Scope of Architectural Service; Advertising for Architects.

ACTION: Mr. DeMassi motioned to send a letter indicating that at least one architect is required to have their license number as stated in N.J.A.C. 13:27-3.2. As for N.J.A.C. 13:27-3.2(b)3, each architect, who is a principal, partner or officer of an architectural business entity, shall be responsible for the form and content of any advertisement which offers to provide architectural services. Ms. Mintz seconded the motion. It passed unanimously.

2 Letter dated June 21, 2006 from Steven A. Brossok of Studio 5 Partnership who requests a clarification of the advertising regulations, specifically do individual license numbers need to appear or is the Certificate of Authorization number sufficient in all advertisements.

ACTION: Mr. DeMassi motioned to send a letter indicating that at least one architect is required to have their license number as stated in N.J.A.C. 13:27-3.2. The Certificate of Authorization number is not sufficient as it is not required. Ms. Mintz seconded the motion. It passed unanimously.

3 Letter dated May 23, 2006 from H. Carleton Godsey, President, NCARB, regarding the Broadly Experience Architect Program (BEA) and requesting the Board to review the attached brochure and consider changing NJ requirements to allow all NCARB Certificate holders to obtain registration.

ACTION: New Jersey Statute does not permit the Board to consider any applicant who does not comply with the education, experience and examination requirements. Mr. DeMassi felt that there may be some way to include architects with NCARB Certificates through the BEA program to become licensed in New Jersey. Mr. Zaccone appointed a subcommittee to review the Board's statutes as well as the Broadly Experience Architect Program requirements and report to the full board of its outcome. Ms. Mintz, Mr. DeMassi and Mr. Whang were appointed to serve on this committee.

4 Copy of an article alleging that the Sea Bright Borough Council assigned Borough Engineer David Hoder to work up the specifications and cost for constructing a new larger municipal building, was received from Jerome Larson Sr. Architect who questions if this is legal?

ACTION: Mr. DeMassi motioned to send a letter to the Sea Bright Borough Council advising that it has come to the board's attention that the Borough Engineer David Hoder was requested to work up the specifications and cost for constructing a new larger municipal building. In accordance with the Building Design Services Act plans for this type of a building classification can only be prepared by an architect. Mr. Kniesler seconded the motion. It passed unanimously.
