C Legislation

1. A4382 - Delays expiration date of certain professional and occupational licenses for individuals with certain types of military service.

ACTION: The Board expressed its concern for a more specific definition of "active service" its too vague in its current format.

2 A4330 - Revises regulation of Landscape Architects

ACTION: It was explained that the Board's comments from their review of A3855 were the same comments made on June 14 when the bill was in the senate committee in addition to comments from the engineers board. DAG updated the board as to the meeting to be held with Joseph Simonetta who represents the architects, engineers societies and two board members from the architects board, engineers board and the landscape architect committee as well as representatives from the Division of Consumer Affairs to discuss the intent behind this legislation. Acting deputy director Larry DeMarzo will reach out to Mr. Simonetta to see if a compromise can be reached to incorporate the boards' comments into the bill.
