Among some issues discussed at the meeting were the ARE computerized test from 3.1 to 4.0 which would convert the current 9-division exam to a 7-section exam. There will be a two year transition where candidates who failed the sections which are to be

combined in the new test have a chance to pass the old sections before being required to take the new section that encompasses the old divisions.

Mr. Zaccone showed off the framed resolution for Kyu-Jung Whang which will be presented to him by Mr. Zaccone at Region II Spring meeting next year in Washington, DC.
