I. Ratification of Minutes

A motion was made by J. Timothy Sensor and seconded by Karen Manista to accept the October 25, 2010, Open Session Minutes with corrections. Motion carried.

II. New Business

A. Report of newly licensed athletic trainers from October 25, 2010 - January 24, 2011.

The list of newly licensed athletic trainers was submitted for informational purposes.

B. Assembly No. 3529 - Requires a public body to record public meetings and post proceedings on its internet website.

The bill was submitted to the Advisory Committee for informational purposes.

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C. Division of Law Billing from Darlene Kane, Budget Officer.

The memorandum detailing the division of law billing for the first quarter of fiscal year 2011 was submitted for informational purposes.

D. 10:30 a.m. Charles Manning, Regulatory Analyst, to speak to the Committee about draft regulations concerning Continuing Education of Athletic Trainers.

Charles Manning discussed the need for the Committee to draft regulations to implement the continuing education (CE) requirements mandated by law. The law now requires that each licensed athletic trainer must complete 24 hours of continuing education each biennial renewal period.

The Committee decided that of the 24 hours of continuing education, at least 2 hours must be related to concussion and head injuries.

The Committee further decided that continuing education providers must be approved by the Board of Certification (BOC).

The Committee will grant CE credits for authorship of textbooks and scholarly journal articles related to the practice of athletic training. The Committee will grant 4 credits per chapter for a maximum of 12 credit hours per biennial renewal cycle.

The Committee will also grant CE credits for the presentation of new seminars or lectures to professionals relating to the practice of athletic training. The Committee will grant 2 credit hours for each hour of seminar or lecture, for a maximum of 12 credit hours per biennial cycle.

Charles Manning will present a draft proposal to the Committee at its next meeting.

E. New Jersey Register - January 03, 2011 Athletic Training Advisory Committee Rule Proposals.

The Athletic Training Advisory Committee's rule proposals, as published in the New Jersey Register was submitted to the Committee for informational purposes.

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III. Adjournment

A motion was made by Karen Manista and seconded by J. Timothy Sensor to adjourn the Public Session and go into Executive Session for the purpose of reviewing confidential matters. Motion carried. Public Session Meeting was adjourned at 11:20 a.m.
