

**New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners
Athletic Training Advisory Committee
Public Session Minutes
February 23, 2009**

I. Ratification of Minutes:

On a motion made by Ms. Manista and seconded by Ms. Camillone, the Committee voted to approve the January 26, 2009 Public Session Minutes as presented. The vote of the Committee was unanimous.

II. Old Business:

A. Committee Discussion with Charles Manning, Regulatory Analyst.

Re: Regulations

Charles Manning, Regulatory Analyst, met with the Committee to discuss revised regulations based on the enactment of Assembly Bill No. 3259, which revised the scope of practice of the athletic training in New Jersey. This law took effect April 8, 2008.

On motion made by Mr. Sensor and seconded Ms. Manista, the Committee voted to remove the language, "Nothing in this section shall be interpreted to prohibit unlicensed individuals from applying bandaging, wrapping, taping, padding or splinting techniques to non-injured athletes" from its regulations as it is contrary to the Practice Act. The vote of the Committee was unanimous.

The additional language and amendment to the Committee's regulations will be presented to the

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Board of Medical Examiners for their review and approval. The vote of the Committee was unanimous.

On a motion made by Mr. Sensor and seconded by Ms. Camillone, the Committee voted to go into Closed Session. The vote of the Committee was unanimous.
