

**New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners
Athletic Training Advisory Committee
Public Session Minutes
May 24, 2010**

A regular meeting of the Athletic Training Advisory Committee was held on Monday, May 24, 2010 in the Monmouth Conference Room on the 7th floor of 124 Halsey Street, Newark, New Jersey. The Advisory Committee Chair William Hyncik, AT, announced that pursuant to the Open Public Meetings Act, notice of this meeting was prepared in the office of the Committee and mailed out to the Secretary of State, the Attorney General, the Star Ledger, the Record, the Press of Atlantic City, the Asbury Park Press, and the Trenton Times. I. Ratification of Minutes

A committee of the Advisory Committee recommended to approve the March 22, 2010 Open Session Minutes.

II. New Business

- A. Charles Manning, Regulatory Analyst, spoke to the committee members about Executive Order #2. The committee members reviewed a list of the rules that have been identified as potentially meeting the criteria of Executive Order #2.
- B. The committee members reviewed a letter from Michael Prybicien, President, Athletic Trainers' Society of New Jersey dated May 3, 2010, requesting guidance on the issue of licensed athletic trainers working at summer sports camps.

¹Since only two of the Advisory Committee members were in attendance, the Committee did not have a quorum.

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A committee of the Advisory Committee recommended that a letter be drafted to Mr. Prybicien notifying him that, for the current summer season, licensed athletic trainers may be permitted to engage in the practice of athletic training at summer sports camps, under the supervision of a New Jersey licensed physician.

- C. The committee members reviewed the Acting Executive Director's Report of newly Licensed Athletic Trainers.
A committee of the Advisory Committee recommended that the report be accepted.

III. Old Business

- A. Letter from Michael Prybicien, President, Athletic Trainers' Society of New Jersey (ATSNJ) dated February 15, 2010, seeking clarification and guidance with regards to physician's supervision, specifically as it relates to chiropractors. (This issue was reviewed at the March 22, 2010 Committee meeting and tabled for later discussion.) Letter to Michael Prybicien, President, Athletic Trainers' Society of New Jersey (ATSNJ) dated May 6, 2010 concerning his inquiry from February 15, 2010.
The committee tabled discussion of this matter.

**Jesse R. Biggins
Consent Order Filed April 14, 2010**

The committee members reviewed a Consent Order, filed April 14, 2010, by the Board of Medical Examiners in the matter of Jesse R. Biggins for violation of N.J.S.A. 45:9-37:37, as he practiced athletic training from February 1, 2009 through July 21, 2009, with an expired license. Mr. Biggins' license to practice athletic training in the State of New Jersey was reinstated on July 21, 2009. The Committee is also in receipt of payment from Mr. Biggins in the amount of \$250.00 satisfying the civil penalty in this matter.

**Melissa A. Kollar
Consent Order Filed April 14, 2010**

The committee members reviewed a Consent Order, filed April 14, 2010, by the Board of Medical Examiners in the matter of Melissa A. Kollar for violation of N.J.S.A. 45:9-37:37 as she practiced athletic training from February 1, 2009 through June 19, 2009, with an expired license. Ms. Kollar's license to practice athletic training in the State of New Jersey was reinstated on June 19, 2009. The Committee is also in receipt of payment from Ms. Kollar in the amount of \$250.00 satisfying

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the civil penalty in this matter.

**Nora V. McCormick
Consent Order Filed April 14, 2010**

The committee members reviewed a Consent Order, filed April 14, 2010, by the Board of Medical Examiners in the matter of Nora V. McCormick for violation of N.J.S.A. 45:9-37:37 as she practiced athletic training from February 1, 2009 through January 29, 2010, with an expired license. Ms. McCormick' license to practice athletic training in the State of New Jersey was reinstated on January 29, 2010. The Committee is also in receipt of payment from Ms. McCormick in the amount of \$1,000.00 satisfying the civil penalty in this matter.
