QUESTION ON HER APPLICATION

As part of the athletic training application an applicant must have a plenary licensed physician with whom they have worked in the last year complete a certificate of Good Moral Character certifying the good moral character of the applicant.

Ms. Geary advised the Committee that she has not worked as an athletic trainer since 2000 and asked whether a plenary licensed physician that she worked with at that time could complete the certificate of Good Moral Character.

A motion was made by Ms. Manista and seconded by Mr. Hyncik to advise Ms. Geary that the last plenary licensed physician that she worked with in 2000 should complete the certificate of Good Moral Character. A vote was taken and the motion carried by a unanimous vote.

B. LETTER FROM RUSSELL ULMER, CONTINUING EDUCATION MANAGER OF THE BOARD OF CERTIFICATION

RE: NOTIFICATION OF CHANGE OF CERTIFICATION STATUS

The Committee reviewed a notification from the Board of Certification concerning the resignation of John Scioscia's certification number 000010377 and considered it informational. According to the notification, once a certification status is listed as resigned, a certified athletic trainer is not permitted to do the following: serve as a supervisor of students who are satisfying the athletic training requirements for certification eligibility; serve as a model or examiner for the BOC Certification Examination; or represent himself or herself to the public as a practicing certified athletic trainer or use the initials, "ATC" or "C.A.T." after their name.
