I. Ratification of Minutes

A subcommittee of the Advisory Committee recommended that a letter be drafted to Mr. Prybicien notifying him that, for the current summer season, licensed athletic trainers may be permitted to engage in the practice of athletic training at summer sports camps, under the supervision of a New Jersey licensed physician.
