**II. Ratification of Minutes
September 23, 2013**

A motion was made by Ms. Manista and seconded by Ms. Camillone to accept the Public Session Minutes of September 23, 2013 with corrections. Motion carried unanimously.

III. Old Business

- A. **1. Bill No. A2882, May 10, 2012 - Amended by the Senate on February 7, 2013**
Senate and General Assembly Bill No. A2882, an act that requires professional Boards to provide credits toward requirements for licensure for veterans with substantially equivalent training.

A motion was previously made in 2012 by Mr. Sensor and seconded by Ms. Camillone to oppose Bill No. A2882 as the Advisory Committee members believes that there is no equivalent requirement or clinical experience required under the Athletic Training Act. However, the Act passed on May 5, 2013. After further investigation it was found that athletic trainers in the military are certified by the Board of Certification (BOC). Motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Ms. Manista and seconded by Mr. Sensor that this Act is not applicable as athletic trainers in the military do not get training which qualifies for licensure requirements.

2. Bill No. A4304/S2923, June 27, 2013

Senate and General Assembly Bill No. A4304/2923, an act that revises statutes regarding practice of physical therapy.

Discussion of this matter was tabled at the September 23, 2013 Advisory Committee's meeting.

Bill No. A4304/S2923 did not take position.

A. Signed and Filed Consent Orders from the State Board of Medical Examiners

1. Jeanne M. Fleming, AT

Consent Order Filed September 11, 2013

The Advisory Committee reviewed a copy of the Consent Order filed September 11, 2013, by the State Board of Medical Examiners in the matter of Jeanne M. Fleming for violation of N.J.S.A. 45:9 -37:37 as she continued to work with an expired license from March 1, 2011 until her license was reinstated on August 15, 2012. The Advisory Committee is also in receipt of payment from Ms. Fleming in the amount of \$250.00 satisfying the civil penalty in this matter.

2. Mark J. Hilla, AT

Consent Order Filed September 11, 2013

The Advisory Committee reviewed a copy of the Consent Order filed September 11, 2013, by the State Board of Medical Examiners in the matter of Mark J. Hilla, AT for violation of N.J.S.A. 45:9 -37:37 as he practiced athletic training in the State of New Jersey from July through August 2011 (prior to being licensed). The Advisory Committee is also in receipt of payment from Mr. Hilla in the amount of \$250.00 satisfying the civil penalty in this matter.
