NEW BUSINESS

1. PUBLIC LAW 2003, C. 214

Attached is a copy of Public Law 2003, c. 214 which requires the Board's licensees to report to the Division of Mental Health Services at the Department of Human Services the suicide, or attempted suicide, of a youth (defined as twenty-four years old or younger).

2. POLICY FOR ACCEPTANCE OF MULTIPLE PRESCRIPTIONS

Attached is correspondence concerning the Board's position concerning the use of multiple prescription written on the date that the patient was seen and a "date to be filled" placed on the prescription. When the Executive Committee reviewed this issue, it discovered that while the Board does not have a problem with this practice, it violates a Department of Health and Senior Services regulation. The Executive Committee seeks the Board's ratification of its position and suggests that the Board support a change in the DHSS regulation which requires a prescription to be filled within thirty days after it is written.
