NEW BUSINESS

1. Assembly Bill No. 2995

Seeks to require health care facilities to continuous monitoring of the status of health care practitioners credentials. It was introduced by Assembly persons Conaway and Connors on or about June 16, 2008. It has been referred to the Assembly Health and Senior Services Committee.

2. Assembly Bill No. 3098

Seeks to include midwives within the definition of "licensed persons" for purposes of affidavits of merit in certain actions filed on or after the effective date. It was introduced on September 15, 2008 by Assembly persons Carroll and Rodriquez and was referred to the Assembly Judiciary Committee.

3. Assembly Bill No. 3110

Seeks to authorize midwives to examine or treat individuals under certain labor laws. It was introduced by Assemblyperson Rodriquez on or about September 15, 2008 and referred to the Assembly Labor Committee.

4. Assembly Bill 3135

Seeks to reinstate the certificate of need requirement for certain ambulatory surgical facilities. It was introduced on September 22, 2008 by Assemblyperson Vainieri and referred to the Assembly Health and Senior Services Committee.
