**PUBLIC SESSION MINUTES
THURSDAY, MARCH 22, 2012 (9:30 A.M.)
SOMERSET ROOM, 6TH FLOOR**

A meeting of the New Jersey Board of Chiropractic Examiners was held on March 22, 2012 at the State Office Building, 124 Halsey Street, 6th floor, Newark New Jersey. The meeting was convened in accordance with the provision of the Open Public Meetings Act with previous notification having been sent to the Secretary of State and the following publications: The Record, Newark Star Ledger, Camden Courier Post, Trenton Times and Asbury Park Press to advise of the scheduling of this meeting. The meeting was called to order by Albert Stabile Jr., D.C., President of the Board, at 9:45 A.M..

I. APPROVAL OF THE PUBLIC SESSION MINUTES OF FEBRUARY 23, 2012

A motion was made by Dr. Spadafino, which was seconded by Dr. Senatore, to approve the public session minutes of February 23, 2012 as amended. A vote was taken and the motion passed with all members present voting in favor.

II. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

HANDOUT: Announcement from the Council on Chiropractic Education dated March 20, 2012. The CCE informed interested parties that the U.S. Department of Education has renewed its recognition of the CCE as the accrediting body for chiropractic schools and programs.

III. AMENDMENTS N.J.A.C. 13:44E - 1.1 & NEW RULES N.J.A.C.13:44E-1A.5 AND 1A.6 FOR PUBLICATION AS ADOPTIONS

Regulatory Analyst Betsy Greenblatt appeared to discuss the final draft of the comments to the proposed regulations, and amendments made to the Board's response and the proposed regulations.

A motion was made by Dr. O'Connor, which was seconded by Dr. Krouse, the Board voted to adopt the regulations for publication. A vote was taken and the motion passed with all members present voting in favor.

IV. C.E. COMMITTEE

A motion was made by Dr. Spadafino, which was seconded Dr. Senatore, to accpet the recommendations of the CE committee. A vote was taken and the motion passed with all members present voting in favor.

V. APPLICATIONS FOR LICENSURE

A. ELIOT HUDES, D.C. (REINSTATEMENT)

New Jersey license expired in 2002, but has been actively licensed in New York State. Dr. Hudes states that he has been employed as a reviewer for insurance company, and part time as a solo practitioner.

A motion was made by Dr. O'Connor, which was Dr. Senatore, to approve Dr. Hudes license pending he complete and pass the Jurisprudence exam. A vote was taken and the motion passed with all members present voting in favor.

B. PETER EDWARDS, D.C. (REINSTATEMENT)

Has not practiced chiropractic since 12/31/2002.

A motion was made by Dr. Krouse, which was Dr. O'Connor, to approve Dr. Edwards' license pending he complete and pass the SPEC & Jurisprudence exam. A vote was taken and the motion passed with all members present voting in favor.

C. LARRY CASE, D.C. (REINSTATEMENT)

Note: his application for reinstatement had been approved at a previous meeting. In February 2012, Dr. Case requested a waiver of the payment of the back licensing fees.

Upon review and advice of counsel, the Board determined that the back licensing fees will be waived for Dr. Case because his license expired in 1999, and did not get the notice of the enactment of the Uniform Enforcement Act in 2001. The Board also determined to add a requirement to continue to attend AA meetings at a minimum of twice weekly to the Consent Order of Reinstatement.

VI. OPEN DISCIPLINARY MATTERS

A. MARK RADOWITZ, D.C.

Attached for Board review is a final assessment report and evaluation filed by the Robert Wood Johnson Medical School on March 3, 2012.

This was received as informational.
