PUBLIC SESSION MINUTES
THURSDAY, JUNE 25, 2015**

A meeting of the New Jersey Board of Chiropractic Examiners was held on June 25, 2015 at the State Office Building, 124 Halsey Street, 7th floor, Newark, New Jersey in the Somerset Conference Room on the 6th floor. The meeting was convened in accordance with the provisions of the Open Public Meetings Act with previous notification having been sent to the Secretary of State and the following publications: The Record, Newark Star Ledger, Camden Courier Post, Trenton Times and Asbury Park Press to advise of the scheduling of this meeting. The meeting was called to order by David Allen, D.C., President of the Board, at 9:45 A.M. A roll call was taken and the following attendance was recorded and a quorum was present:

I. APPROVAL OF THE PUBLIC SESSION MINUTES OF MAY 28, 2015

A motion was made by Dr. O'Connor, which was seconded by Dr. Lyons, to approve the public session minutes from the May 28, 2015 Board meeting as amended. A vote was taken and the motion passed with all members voting in favor.

II. CONTINUING EDUCATION COMMITTEE

The continuing education committee reviewed 55 courses submitted by continuing education sponsors. The committee recommended that 53 courses be approved based on the information submitted for these courses. A motion was made by Dr. Calio and seconded by Dr. Winters, to approve the 53 courses as recommended by the committee. A vote was taken and motion passed with all members present voting in favor.

- A. Dr. John Nosti
Course - The Professional's Role in Nutritional Counseling

A motion was made by Dr. Calio and seconded by Dr. O'Connor to deny the course, "The Professional's Role in Nutritional Counseling" as the Curriculum Vitae of the speaker did not include a background in nutrition. A vote was taken and the motion passed with all member present voting in favor.

Course - First Line Therapy Certification

A motion was made by Dr. Calio and seconded by Dr. O'Connor to deny the course, "First Line Therapy Certification" as the course contents use proprietary products. A vote was taken and the motion passed with all members present voting in favor.

D. Discussion with Elizabeth Greenblatt, Regulatory Analyst
RE: Regulations

The Board discussed with Regulatory Analyst, Elizabeth Greenblatt, a section of the Uniform Enforcement Act (P.L. 2013, c.182) which became effective on July 1, 2014. The section modified the reinstatement and reactivation requirements for professional or occupational licensees, registrants, and certificate holders. The Board also discussed endorsement and continuing education requirements.

Dr. O'Connor provided the Board with a verbal update on FCLB activities.
