**PUBLIC SESSION MINUTES**

**THURSDAY, JULY 22, 2010**

A meeting of the New Jersey Board of Chiropractic Examiners was held July 22, 2010 at the State Office Building, 124 Halsey Street, 6<sup>th</sup> floor, Newark New Jersey. The meeting was convened in accordance with the provision of the Open Public Meetings Act with previous notification having been sent to the Secretary of State and the following publications: The Record, Newark Star Ledger, Camden Courier Post, Trenton Times and Asbury Park Press to advise of the scheduling of this meeting. The meeting was called to order by Michael Krouse, D.C., President of the Board, at 9:45 A.M..

**The meeting was conducted as a committee because a quorum was not present. The recommendations of the committee may be ratified at a future meeting.**

**II. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

Executive Director Eisenmenger reported that to date in July, the Board office received 7 applications and issued 5 licenses. He reported that for the fiscal year 2009-2010, the Board received 123 applications and issued 136 licenses.

**III. PIC SCHEDULE**

The committee discussed the recent executive orders issued by the governor, and the impact they may have on Board meetings. The committee also discussed the possibility of holding PICs in the afternoons after regular Board meetings. The Executive Director will work with the Board members to see if this will work in the future.

**IV. RULES & REGULATIONS COMMITTEE**

Dr. Spadafino reported on the committee meeting held by telephone conference on Friday, July 16, 2010. He stated that the rules and regulations committee recommends that the Board reconsider the regulatory proposal to examine additional information concerning the inclusion of PACE in the continuing education section.

**On a motion by Dr. Spadafino, seconded by Dr. Calio, the committee of the Board recommends that the previously adopted proposal be reconsidered or amended. The committee voted 5-0 to recommend that the full Board consider this matter again at the September meeting.**

Dr. Fuchs inquired about whether breast thermography is within the Chiropractic scope of practice, and, if so, requests that the Board provide her with appropriate guidelines for its use. The committee considered NJAC 13:44E-3.2(c)(3), which states that thermography is only approved in certain situation.

**On a motion by Dr. Calio, seconded by Dr. Spadafino, the committee recommends issuing Dr. Fuchs a response that the regulation is specific about what situations thermography is appropriate, and refer her to NJAC 13:30A-3.2(c) (3).**

**On a motion by Dr. Calio, seconded by Dr. Spadafino, the committee recommends referring this matter to the rules and regulations committee to review and determine if promulgating further regulatory guidance is appropriate.**
