The report of inspection reflects that the shop only contains 326 square feet of floor space, 24 square feet short of the minimum required by N.J.A.C. 13:28-2.5 but he has indicated that it is impossible for her to enlarge or rent additional space; and that the fact that the floor space is twenty-four (24) square feet short does not result in the inability for his client to provide authorized services in a safe and sanitary manner. He also stated that although there are three (3) work stations depicted in the enclosed photographs, his client will remove one work station. Ms. Mendez asks that the Board waive its minimum square footage requirement and issue the desired license.
