PUBLIC SESSION

I CALL TO ORDER

Upon motion made by Ms. Frances Tomeo and seconded by Mr. Peter Macri, the matter was tabled. The motion passed unanimously.

2. Mr. Joseph Visconti, Joan Welgus and Lynette Trovitch of Jolie Hair and Beauty Academy, 801 Tilton Road, Northfield, New Jersey and their supervising teacher, Ms. Nancy Daiutolo appeared before the Board of Cosmetology and Hairstyling for interview in connection with their application for initial school licensure of Jolie Hair and Beauty Academy.

Mr. Joseph Visconti, Joan Welgus, Lynette Trovitch and Ms. Nancy Daiutolo answered questions of the Board.

Upon motion made by Ms. Frances Tomeo and seconded by Mr. Peter Macri, the school application for Jolie Hair and Beauty Academy is approved subject to a favorable school inspection. The motion passed unanimously.

Agenda Supplement

1. Bill comment request for A3851 was presented to the Board.

Upon motion made by Ms. Frances Tomeo and seconded by Mr. Peter Macri, the Board is opposed to this bill in its present form and indicated it was too broad in scope and the level and dept of oversight would be difficult and costly to maintain. The motion passed

unanimously.

2. Presentation of draft regulations on barber license for Board approval.

Upon motion by Mr. Peter Macri and seconded by Ms. Frances Tomeo, the Board approves the draft regulations on barber license for presentation to interested parties at a meeting to be scheduled on April 21, 2011 and absent any substantial changes to the draft as a result of that meeting, the Board votes to propose the draft regulations. The motion passed unanimously.

3. Correspondence received from Mr. Hueston McNulty, Esquire, Stonebridge Community Association Research on a shop license for a private community was presented to the Board for consideration.

Upon motion by Peter Macri and seconded by Mr. Jerry Speziale, after careful consideration, the Board determined that Stonebridge Community Association Research does not fall within one of the enumerated exceptions pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:5B-8; therefore prior to operation, Stonebridge Community Association Research must obtain a license to operate pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:5B-9 and must satisfy all licensure requirements in order to obtain a shop license pursuant to N.J.A.C. 13:28-2.1 et seq. The motion passed unanimously.

4. Issue Re: Unlicensed Shops and unlicensed practice pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-18-1 et seq.

Upon motion by Ms. Frances Tomeo and seconded by Mr. James Forte, after careful consideration, the Board authorizes the Board office (with advice of counsel) to review all unlicensed practice complaints including unlicensed facilities and where appropriate, to impose penalties and fines and to instruct all unlicensed practice to cease and desist from operating without a license. The motion passed unanimously.

5. Periodic Report on Legislation was presented to the Board for information.

The Board acknowledged the information.

6. Correspondence from Dr. Teri Stallone, ED, Principal, Gloucester Township Campus, in

connection with informing the Board that the Adult Curriculum for Cosmetology and Hairstyling will no longer be offered at the Sicklerville Campus and is seeking the Board's permission to transfer the Adult Cosmetology and Hairstyling Curriculum to Gloucester Township, Camden County College affective July 1, 2011 was presented to the Board for consideration.

After careful consideration, the Board approved this request. The motion passed unanimously.

7. A request from Mr. Santo Trapani for permission for EEG, Inc. Empire New Jersey Schools to attend the annual Future Professionals Expo, Hershey, PA on May 15-16, 2011 and for their students to be allowed to attend and earn hours during the function was presented to the Board for consideration.0 The schools participating are Empire Beauty Schools, Bordentown. Cherry Hill, Laurel Springs and Paramus, European Academy of Cosmetology, Union, Concorde School of Hair Design, Bloomfield, Ocean and Natural Motion Institute of Hair Design, Jersey City.

Upon motion made by Mr. James Forte and seconded by Mr. Jerry Speziale, Mr. Trapani's request is approved. The motion passed unanimously.
