PUBLIC SESSION MINUTES

**I. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

April 19, 2006 - Approved as amended.

**II. COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

A. Credentials:

Dental Auxiliaries:

1. Marlene McMickley, RDH - The committee discussed a request for reinstatement of her dental hygiene license which expired in 1997. The committee requested that additional information be obtained. A reinstatement application will be sent to Ms. McMickley.
2. Lorraine Pinkston, RDH - Application for a dental hygiene license by credentials. Ms. Pinkston meets all requirements for licensure. The committee recommends approval.
3. Jan Corliss, RDA - Application for a registered dental assistant registration. Ms. Corliss meets all requirements for registration. The committee recommends approval.
4. Bridget Christaldi, RDA - Application for a registered dental assistant registration. Ms. Christaldi meets all requirements for registration. The committee recommends approval.
5. Rae Quinn, RDA - Reinstatement application for a registered dental assistant registration. The committee recommends approval.

Dental:

1. Dr. Jennifer To - Application for a residency permit. The committee recommends approval pending receipt of the National Board scores and a letter from the Dean of the school.
2. Dr. Christopher Williams - Application for a dental license. The committee recommends that an appearance be scheduled concerning information disclosed on his application.

B. Continuing Education:

1. Executive Director Kevin Earle advised the Board that applications from the following licensees were

received that took courses to be used towards the Enteral Sedation permit, however, these courses were not the 20 and 40 hour programs initially approved by the Board:

The Board determined that the combination of courses submitted by the above licensees meet the regulations. The Board determined to approve these applications for Enteral Sedation permits.

### **III. APPEARANCES:**

A. 1:00 P.M. - Jessica Scalia, RDH - Ms. Scalia appeared before the Board concerning information disclosed on her application for a dental hygiene license.

At the conclusion of testimony by Ms. Scalia and questions from the Board, the inquiry was ended.

After discussing this matter, the Board in a motion by Dr. Placa, seconded by Dr. Hall approved Ms. Scalia's application. A letter of advice will be sent to Ms. Scalia advising her that similar future incidents may reflect negatively on her license.

B. 1:50 P.M. - Nicole Diana, RDA - Ms. Diana appeared before the Board concerning information disclosed on her application for a Registered Dental Assistant registration.

At the conclusion of testimony by Ms. Diana and questions from the committee, the inquiry was ended.

The committee moved to Executive Session for deliberation.

C. 2:00 P.M. - Mildred Albert, RDA - Ms. Albert appeared before the Board concerning information disclosed on her application for a Registered Dental Assistant registration.

At the conclusion of testimony by Ms. Albert and questions from the committee, the inquiry was ended.

After discussing this matter, the committee recommended that Ms. Albert's application be approved.

### **IV. OTHER MATTERS:**

A. Andrew Rudnick, D.M.D. - The Board reviewed a request that the disciplinary action from 1998 for a continuing education penalty be removed from his record. Dr. Rudnicki indicates that he is applying for a license in the State of Nevada and they are questioning this disciplinary action.. After discussing this matter the Board determined to send a letter of explanation to the Nevada Board.

B. Ronald Rosen, D.D.S. - The Board discussed this case to determine whether it will retain jurisdiction of the case or refer it to the Office of Administrative Law for trial. After discussing this matter, the Board determined to refer this matter to the Office of Administrative Law.

C. Roy L. Rambo, D.M.D. - The Board considered the sanction to be imposed in this matter, including the Attorney General's application for costs and attorneys' fees. The Board noted that no response was received from Dr. Rambo concerning this matter. The Board determined that Dr. Rambo will be assessed full attorney's fees and costs.

D. ADA - Inquiry as to whether a member wants to assist with the administration of the National Board

Examinations. The Board took this as informational.
