**I. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** May 4, 2011 - Approved as amended

**II. COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

1. Credentials:

Dr. Gopi Voonna - Application for dental license along with additional information requested by the Board. The Board approved Dr. Voonna's license as of July 2011 when the dentist will have completed five years of practice in one state.

2. Continuing Education:

The Board approved the continuing education committee recommendations.

**III. OTHER MATTERS:**

1. The Board reviewed additional information from Dr. Louis Malcmacher with regard to their request for approval of a course to comply with the Board's proposed regulation for the Administration of Injectable Pharmacologics. They are also questioning whether individuals that have already taken their 18-19 hour BoTox course be qualified if they make up the extra 2 or 3 hours in a separate course.  
The Board questioned whether the this "school" in Lakewood is an appropriate setting for this course. The Board determined that Dr. Malcmacher be invited to appear before the Board at an upcoming public meeting to discuss this course.
2. The Board reviewed an inquiry from Dr. David Kilber concerning Dental Utilization Review Licensing/Registration requirements. The Board referred Dr. Kilber to its statute, NJSA 45:6-16.
3. Dr. Alex Silman - Inquiry in follow-up to the Board's Final Order of Discipline filed on February 17, 2010. The Board moved this matter to executive session for deliberation. The Board determined that additional information be obtained.

The Board is not opposed to this but, noted that residents are not allowed to rotate through private offices, but must be in the premises of the clinical facility of the hospital or university.
