VII OTHER MATTERS:

A. Dr. Shahrzad Mazandarani - Inquiry questioning whether "a dentist without an Enteral Conscious Sedation permit can perform dentistry on a patient who has received sedation medication administered by another dentist in the office who does have an enteral sedation permit."

After a review of the Board's enteral sedation regulations at N.J.A.C. 13:30-8.4, the Board opined that any dentist who administers enteral sedation is required to remain immediately in the operatory to ensure that the patient's protective reflexes are sufficient to protect the patient's airway and the patient can breathe spontaneously and without assistance. The dentist must remain in the operatory until such time as the patient is determined to be stable and ready for discharge.

B. Irena Badzelewicz, DDS - Inquiry concerning "administration of Restylane/Non Animals Stabilized Hialuronic Acid/ as intradermal injections in dental office."

The Board reported that an ad-hoc committee had reviewed the issue and recommended the development of a regulation establishing certain educational standards for the use of these pharmacological adjuvants. After review by the Board, the matter was referred back to the committee for further consideration.

C. Joseph C. Venditto, DMD - Proof of completion of the ProBe Program as required by Board Order.
