I. APPROVAL OF MINUTES: July 6, 2011

The Board in a motion by Ms. Birenz, seconded by Dr. Hall approved the minutes as amended.

II. COMMITTEE REPORTS:

1. Continuing Education:

(a) Additional information from Dr. Bruce G. Freund on behalf of the American Academy of Facial Cosmetics concerning approval of a course in the administration of injectable pharmacologics.

The Board in a motion by Dr. Feinberg, seconded by Dr. Dashkow, approved this course with the Board's expectation that Dr. Freund include a portion in his course about the limitations of practice and the regulations governing the use of injectable pharmacologics.

Dr. Dolinsky and Dr. Feinberg expressed the Board's sentiment that these injectable agents must be administered in an appropriate clinical setting, in the same manner that any other type of dentistry would be performed.

(b) Additional information from Dr. Louis Malcmacher, President, American Academy of Facial Esthetics, concerning approval of a course in the administration of injectable pharmacologics.

The Board in a motion by Dr. Feinberg, seconded by Dr. Hall, approved this course to comply with the regulations once published.

Dr. Malcmacher asked whether individuals who have already taken his 16 hour continuing education course would qualify under the proposed regulations if they completed a special 5 hour course to make up the additional hours.

The Board in a motion by Dr. Feinberg, seconded by Dr. Dashkow, determined that any dentist who has taken any similar continuing education courses prior to board approval of the 21 hour courses must complete a board-approved 21 hour course in the administration of injectable pharmacological agents.

(c) Application from Dr. Paul J. Condello, Jersey Shore University Medical Center, requesting approval of a course in the administration of injectable dermal filler pharmacologics.

The Board in a motion by Dr. Feinberg, seconded by Dr. Hall, approved this application with the request that Dr. Condello provide a more detailed breakdown for the 21 hours described in the outline provided.

III. PROVISIONAL ORDER OF DISCIPLINE TO BE FINALIZED:

1. Dr. Sofiya Bondar - Moved to Executive Session. The Board determined to finalize the POD as written.
2. Dr. Heidi Glick Starr - Moved to Executive Session. The Board determined to issue a Final Order of Discipline.

IV. APPEARANCES:

1. 11:00 A.M. - Dr. Michael Stahl - Appearance concerning his request for reinstatement of the New Jersey dental license. Dr. Stahl appeared without counsel. Dr. David was recused from this matter because Dr. Stahl once worked for an associate of Dr. David. This inquiry was moved to executive session for deliberation. At the conclusion of the deliberation's the Board voted to reinstate Dr. Stahl's license.
2. 2:00 P.M. - Dr. Kenneth Avery - Appearance concerning his request for reinstatement of the New Jersey dental license which was surrendered by Order filed January 19, 2011. Dr. Avery appeared with Dr. Baxter from the PAPNJ.

The committee recommends reinstating Dr. Avery's license with the recommendations of the PAPNJ.
