VI. APPEARANCES:

1. 11:00 A.M. - Dr. Patrick Bamgboye - Consideration of initial decision from the Office of Administrative Law.

Dr. Bamgboye appeared with counsel, Mr. Richard Tanner. Deputy Attorney General Kay Ehrenkrantz appeared on behalf of the State. Dr. Dolinsky was recused.

DAG Ehrenkrantz urged the Board to find that the record supported a basis for discipline against Dr. Bamgboye. Mr. Tanner urged the Board to accept the initial decision as written.

On a motion by Ms. Birenz, seconded by Dr. Kupiec, the Board determined to modify and reject the initial decision of Judge Solomon. The Board, based on the record, found that Dr. Bamgboye in his treatment of K.P. had engaged in repeated acts of negligence and had violated the Board's regulation on record keeping. A mitigation hearing has been scheduled for September 1, 2010.
